How do you tell if you have Fleas?

Ctenocephalides felis, Cat fleas are the most common they grow up to 3mm in length and tend to bite around the ankles and legs, although bites in other locations are not uncommon.

Indicators of Fleas

- Pets Excessive scratching or discomfort of animals such as cats and dogs.
- Sightings Small dark insects jumping around on furniture animals or bedding.

Treating Fleas

It is very important that Fleas are treated as soon as they are identified as the eggs can lay dormant until a person enters the property hatching at the vibrations of footsteps. .
