

2	Minutes
	<p>Everyone agreed the minutes from 22 March 2017 were correct.</p> <p>We talked about the actions that have not been finished from earlier meetings.</p>
3	Working group updates
  	<p>People in the meeting talked about the different working groups.</p> <p><i>Dementia information - working group</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This group has now finished. There were some questions about the action plan. • Ella will send an updated action plan. <p><i>Crash Pad service – working group</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There have been two meetings, one with Mencap and one with People Bank members • Nicola talked about the group. They looked at different names for the service and also about how it will work. • Ella said the meetings have been very useful. Lots of the suggestions have been accepted by the service. <p><i>Telecare</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The group has met 2 times. They will meet 1 more time. • They looked at what information people would like about the service. They looked at how this information can be clear. • Nicola said that her favourite part was learning about new equipment. <p><i>Making services accessible to everyone</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This group has met 2 times and will meet 1 more time. • They are putting together a guide for providers to



 	<p>make services more accessible in Barnet. Providers are organisations or companies who run services like day centres, supported living and home care in Barnet.</p> <p>Hospital discharge</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This group hasn't started yet. In the meeting people said that it should apply to all hospitals including mental health. • Ella will contact the Involvement Board before the first meeting to get their opinions. <p>End of life care</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There are two dates for this group: Friday 30 June and Friday 21 July. <p>The group said it can be confusing why working groups are starting at different times.</p> <p>Emily said that this is because of different reasons. Sometimes the right people are not available to help. Sometimes it needs to happen at a time when it can make more of a difference.</p>
<p>4</p>  	<p>Annual Summit</p> <p>Ella gave an update about the Annual Summit which will be held on Thursday 6 July.</p> <p>We had a steering group to help plan the summit which has been very useful.</p> <p>For the Annual Summit, we put together a list of 20 different topics.</p> <p>These are things that are important to the Council, health services and members of the Involvement Board.</p> <p>In the meeting, people worked in groups to choose their 5 most important topics.</p> <p>These will be the topics that are taken to the Annual Summit for more people to vote on.</p> <p>The 10 most popular topics will be the priorities for the year.</p>
