

Sign Video at Barnet House



Deaf people living in Barnet can use the Sign Video interpreting service to talk to someone from the council. This is free.

What you need to do.

- If possible, arrange a time to meet or contact the member of staff
- The Sign Video interpreting service can be used at Barnet House
- It is open from 9am to 5pm, Monday to Friday (not Bank Holidays)

How does it work?

- You use a computer screen to see a BSL interpreter in a private room
- The interpreter can see you, and hear who is talking in the room
- The person you are meeting may be in the room with you, or the interpreter can telephone another Barnet council office to talk to someone

Travelling by underground


The nearest underground station is Totteridge & Whetstone on the Northern Line (High Barnet Branch). It is a 5-minute walk to Barnet House.

Buses 34, 125, 234, 251, 263, 326 and 383 stop near The Griffin (Whetstone) near Barnet House.
