

## Supporting Young People Looking for Work - Job Placement Scheme

If you have answered yes to the above, this project, in partnership with the London Borough of Barnet entitled **Voluntary Sector Capacity Building** will be of interest to your organisation.

The project has been developed to provide **a nine month work placement for twenty young people between the ages of 16 – 18**. A Skills and Enterprise Adviser will work with the young people, who are **not in education, employment and training and living in disadvantaged areas**.

CommUNITY Barnet are keen to identify **voluntary and community organisations within Barnet who are able to provide an opportunity for the above young people**.

**Funding for the organisation to support the nine month placement is available.**



Two information mornings have been planned at which you will be able to submit an expression of interest. The **first information morning will be held on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> August, the second information morning will be held on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> August, both sessions will be held at the Rainbow Centre.**

To submit an expression of interest you will need to have identified a role for a young person and have a job description in place.
