





Percentage of Pupils achieving Key Stage 1 Level 2+ Maths













Percentage of pupils achieving L3+ in Maths





Appendix 37: Percentage of pupils achieving Level 3+ in Writing at Key Stage 1





Percentage of achieving Key Stage 2 Level 5+ Maths




















