The interim review will commence on **Friday 27 January 2017** and will be completed in sufficient time to enable the Electoral Registration Officer to make any alterations necessary to the register of electors (including to elector numbers) when the monthly update is published on **Tuesday 2 May 2017**.

The (Acting) Returning Officer (ARO) for the three Parliamentary constituencies represented within the borough will make a proposal on the arrangements for all current polling districts and polling places. Any elector registered in the area of the London Borough of Barnet may make a representation on any existing polling district and/or polling place or on the ARO's proposals and may suggest alternative venues and locations to an existing polling place. Any such representations should be delivered:
