A Core library will include:

- The most popular books
- Some space for study
- Homework support
- A range of activities focused on children and older adults
- Limited staffed opening hours
- Self-Service Opening*
- Community space for hire.

Key proposed changes:

- The library space will remain relatively unchanged although it will be slightly reduced in footprint
- A new screen will be provided around the central staircase.

*Burnt Oak Library will have a slightly different Self-Service Opening arrangement as it is co-located in a building with Housing Benefits and the BOOST team. There is a security guard currently present who will be on-site when the library is both staffed and unstaffed. There will not be self-service entry technology, however other elements such as the CCTV and self-service library facilities will be the same. Unlike the other Core and Core Plus libraries, there will not be extended early morning and late evening opening hours.
