This public exhibition is designed to provide you with more information on Barnet Council's proposal to re-develop the Abbots Depot Site on Oakleigh Road South.

Barnet Council is in discussions to acquire the Abbots Depot Site as a base for its fleet of household waste and recycling collection vehicles.

The existing base in Mill Hill needs to be relocated and this new site would help keep a cap on the cost of refuse collection in Barnet by reducing the number of long distance journeys that have to be taken by the refuse and recycling collection fleet.

It is important to the Council that you share your views on the proposal. Feedback will be taken on board and will help to shape the final proposal for the site before a planning application is submitted later in the year.

Feedback received during this pre-application consultation will be considered and used to help shape the final design for the site and planning application. People wishing to submit feedback have until **Monday 13 April 2015** to provide their thoughts as part of this pre-application stage.

Following this, the aim is to submit a planning application to Barnet Council's Planning Committee in summer 2015.

Should planning permission be granted, development will commence in autumn 2015, with the new Depot becoming fully operational around December 2016.

Throughout the development period, Barnet Council will continue to communicate with local residents and businesses to ensure that on-site activity causes minimal disturbance.
