What is re-use?

Re-use allows something to be used again rather than being thrown into landfill or broken up for recycling. By re-using items you can extend the life of many everyday products. The London Re-use Network is made up of re-use projects, including charities, across London that work together to find new homes for donated furniture and household items. 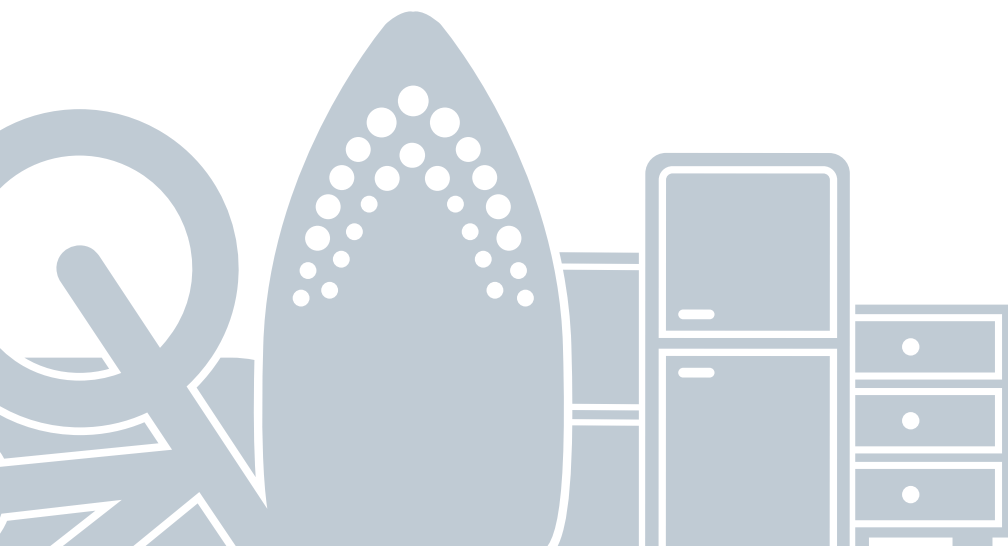
